

**BO HOAG ( -14)**

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**Q. Sixty-four, your second this week. Seven birdies, no bogeys. Your thoughts on how you played today?**

**BO HOAG:** Yeah, just one of those solid rounds. No bogeys, just kept the train running there and just made a lot of early birdies and just kept going with it.

**Q. Five birdies on the front, two on the back, and today as opposed to yesterday, five of five scrambling getting up and down.**

**BO HOAG:** Yeah, some really good up-and-downs to kind of keep everything just going forward. After dropping a shot there and getting it back, I just kept moving forward, so that was nice.

**Q. Seventeen, you're in the left rough. What was the thought process there on laying up? Did you think at first, hey, maybe I can get this to go?**

**BO HOAG:** Yeah, maybe. You know, unfortunately, if you get in the rough on the left there on 17, it just kind of kills the distance a little bit, so a normal 3-wood on the fairway would have gotten farther down. Just a little too far with the into-left-right wind today, so hitting good wedges all day.

**Q. Chance to win the golf tournament tomorrow. What have you learned about this course over the first three days that's going to help you tomorrow?**

**BO HOAG:** I hope the wind blows. I've always felt that's an advantage for me even though sometimes I might not be so comfortable on the shot. You kind of wish it was dead, but overall I know it's an advantage for me. I've been playing solid golf and looking forward to it.
