*Weather: Partly cloudy, with a high of 73. Wind NNW at 12-18 mph. The second round was suspended due to darkness at 6:40 p.m. Friday local time with four players left to complete the round. The second round resumed at 7:41 a.m. Saturday*

**Cut:** 68 professionals at 1-over 143 from a field of 132 professionals; highest cut (in relation to par) in a non-major since 2020 the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide (+3)

**Things to Know**

- Ryan Armour seeks second PGA TOUR victory in his 189<sup>th</sup> start
- Wyndham Clark holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for first time on PGA TOUR in search of first TOUR title
- Fred Funk joins Sam Snead, Jack Nicklaus and Tom Watson as only players 64 and older to make the cut in a PGA TOUR event since 1970
- Kiradech Aphibarnrat was the only player without a bogey in the second round
- Seven of the 11 players within three strokes of the lead have yet to win on TOUR
- Two players have converted a 36-hole lead/co-lead for the win this season (Hudson Swafford/Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, Martin Laird/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Due to the cancellation of the 2020 World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions, the Bermuda Championship is a standalone event in 2020 and the winner will receive 500 FedExCup points

**Ryan Armour (T1/-8)**

- Following a T8 finish in last year's inaugural Bermuda Championship, shares the lead through 36 holes in 2020
- Marks fourth time with 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2017 Wyndham Championship/T4, 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship/1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 Quicken Loans National/2<sup>nd</sup>)
- All six rounds at Port Royal are under par; 70-66-65-68-64-70
- 44-year-old seeks his second career TOUR victory in his 189<sup>th</sup> start; won the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship
- Looks to join Stewart Cink (Safeway Open) and Sergio Garcia (Sanderson Farms Championship) as players in their 40s to win this season

- In four prior starts this season, made just one cut (T46/Sanderson Farms Championship) despite posting four sub-par opening rounds and four even-par second rounds
- Last three seasons have been his best performances in the FedExCup Playoffs (2020/101<sup>st</sup>, 2019/100<sup>th</sup>, 2018/49<sup>th</sup>)

#### Wyndham Clark (T1/-8)

- Making his first appearance at the Bermuda Championship, reached 10-under before closing bogey, bogey, par on his final three holes; holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for first time on TOUR
- Recorded an eagle at No. 2 for the second time this week; marks third event of his PGA TOUR career to make multiple eagles (2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST, 2020 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Owns four top-10s in 61 prior TOUR starts, with three coming in 2019 (T10/Puerto Rico Open, T7/The Honda Classic, T5/3M Open)
- T13 in his last start (Shriners Hospitals for Children Open) is best result in three prior starts this season

#### Fred Funk (T37/-1)

- In his 650<sup>th</sup> start and grouped with son, Taylor, 64-year-old finished birdie, par, birdie – including a chip-in on his 36<sup>th</sup> hole (No. 9) – to make his first 36-hole cut on the PGA TOUR since the 2017 Sony Open in Hawaii (T74)
- Last player aged 64 or older to make the cut on TOUR; Tom Watson/2015 RBC Heritage/65
- Prior to this week, only three players aged 64 or older had made the cut on TOUR (Sam Snead, Jack Nicklaus, Tom Watson) since 1970; Snead, at 67, holds the record for oldest player to make a cut
- Owns eight PGA TOUR titles and nine PGA TOUR Champions victories

#### Additional Notes

- **Kramer Hickok** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-7) owns one top-10 in 51 starts on TOUR (T10/2019 Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship)
- Sponsor exemption **Ollie Schniederjans** (T4/-6) birdied his final two holes to reach 6-under; the 2019 Bermuda Championship (MC) was the only PGA TOUR event he played in the 2019-20 season after finishing No. 180 in the FedExCup in the 2018-19 season
- Former Clemson standout and 2017 U.S. Amateur winner **Doc Redman's** (T4/-6) three career top-10s are all top-3 finishes (2<sup>nd</sup>/2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic, T3/2020 Wyndham Championship, T3/2020 Safeway Open); second-round even-par 71 ends his streak of sub-par scores this season at 11
- **Kiradech Aphibarnrat's** 66 (T6/-5) marks his lowest round on TOUR since round three at the 2020 AT&T Pebble Beach (64) and his 11<sup>th</sup> bogey-free round on TOUR (217 rounds); moves from T80 to T6 following first-round 71
- Former World No. 1 **Luke Donald** (T6/-5) seeks 80<sup>th</sup> career top-10 and first since 2019 Valspar Championship (T9)
- First-round leader **Peter Malnati** (T6/-5) managed just two birdies in round two after making nine in round one
- **Padraig Harrington** (T12/-4) is 10-of-12 in scrambling through 36 holes
- **Will Zalatoris** (T37/-1) came into the week three points shy of earning Special Temporary Membership to the PGA TOUR while seeking his fourth top-10 finish in his fifth start of the season (T6/U.S. Open, T8/Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, T5/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Defending Bermuda Championship winner **Brendon Todd** (+4) did not advance to the weekend
- Bermudians in the field: **Michael Sims** (73-74—147), **Camiko Smith** (71-81—152), **Anthony Phipps** (76-85—161)
- **Henrik Stenson** withdrew with a foot injury during the second round; **Michael Gellerman** withdrew after play was suspended Friday; **Pat Perez** and **Robert Garrigus** withdrew after the second round was completed
