Q. Good round, great finish. What did you like about your round?

My short game was perfect today, which I've been working on it a little bit, but I can't say I've been working really hard. I've only played a couple times in the past few weeks, maybe a month. Played a couple Monday qualifiers and played OK, but I was just coming out to shake the rust off and have a good time today and I guess I did. It was a lot of fun.

Q. You mentioned to Doug Bell you made a putter change recently?

ROBERT GARRIGUS: Yeah, yeah, an Odyssey Jailbird with the big grip on it, the one that Rickie and Keegan use. I switch putters every five minutes on my carpet at home because I'm just there and that's all I get to do.

I really like the way I got this little putting, you know, it's like a little piece of carpet that you can putt on on hardwood. I was rolling that Odyssey putter so good, I'm like, man, I'm gonna -- nothing's going left, because my miss is always left with the putter. Everything was starting right online if not a hair right. I said this is going to be good if I can get a chance to play.

And thank God I got in this tournament. The people here in this tournament, Jevon and Danielle, they gave me a sponsor invite to start, but I didn't need it in the end because my number got in.

Just knowing that I was playing in a tournament like gave me a little juice and the putter definitely helped today.

Q. Got in on the past champion status, but what was it like when you received that sponsor? How did they let you know?

ROBERT GARRIGUS: You know, I was already coming here for kind of a pseudo vacation if I didn't get in because this is one of our favorite places in the world. My girlfriend and I -- Lauren, she's amazing -- we're like man, why don't we just go to Bermuda and see if we get in.
