ADAM SCOTT (-6)

Q. Adam, 3 under the first five holes and then 4 under the last six. What are your thoughts on today's round?

ADAM SCOTT: It was lots of good stuff. I think I made nine -- well, I made seven birdies and an eagle, so that's all good. I just got a little unstuck on these long par 3s, I didn't hit any of those greens. If you're missing greens, it can be tough around here, the lies can be tough. I think I got a couple bad lies today and I missed a few putts that I wished I would have made. So there was a few more out there. We saw low scores, so that's kind of how I feel. I'm playing good, so I'm happy with that.

Q. Played here in 2013 in the PGA Grand Slam of Golf, but this is your debut in this championship. What was the incentive to play here in Bermuda?

ADAM SCOTT: Well, as some people may know, I was in Boston launching the TGL team Boston Common golf on Monday and it was kind of on my way back home to Europe. One last crack at kind of improving my FedExCup standing and with a victory or something I might be able to jump into that spot where I get in those signature events at the start of the year.

So I also have to play in Australia in a couple weeks' time, so it was a good time to get the systems going again and come and play here at a course that I had a little bit of success on a long time ago.
