Q. Thanks for joining us guys, Oliver and Michael. Just want to recap the couple of days that you spent together. Maybe we'll start with you, Oliver, since it was your first (inaudible.) What's the experience been like for you?

OLIVER BETSCHART: Playing with Michael's been a lot of fun. We've played many rounds before together and we're just always chatting around, you know, having fun out there, playing some golf.

But you don't get that back, so I think that was so cool. Very proud of him.

Q. You finished under par for the two rounds. I know it's off the cut line. Is that right? They had you at 1 under.

MICHAEL SIMS: One under today.

Q. So one over. How would you characterize your two days on the golf course?

MICHAEL SIMS: I mean, it was good. I'd be lying if I wasn't saying that to you. Very sloppy at times, really good at times. You know, the last time I played competitively was here last year, so yeah, it showed. It was a lot of rust out there. But once you get in the rhythm of it all, I think you start kind of cruising and going. It was a lot of fun.

Q. Was there a particular highlight for each of you out there the last couple days, one that really stood out, like that was really cool?

OLIVER BETSCHART: For me it was on 18 yesterday, making my birdie. That was kind of the highlight for me there. Everybody watching, the whole crowd around 18 there, that was a special moment.

Q. Are you kind of sad it's over now?

OLIVER BETSCHART: A little bit. I wish I could have made the cut and played on, but wasn't meant to be this year. Try again next year.

Q. Gives you inspiration for next year?

OLIVER BETSCHART: It does, it definitely does.
