ALEX NOREN (-19)



Q. We'll start off with thoughts playing in the final grouping today and will be again tomorrow for the final round.

ALEX NOREN: Yeah, it's what I want to do. This is what you dream of, having a chance to win and being up in the final group on a Saturday, Sunday. I really enjoyed it today. As long as you hit it low, it's not going to be that much, you know, like a whole new course, but you're just going to have to think about it a little bit more than today.

Q. Players like Stewart Cink are up there, you played with Ryan Moore today, tomorrow with Camilo. What does that say about experience kind of dominating for this week?



ALEX NOREN: Yeah, it's nice to see Camilo up there. We live close to each other and it's great to see him up there. Yeah, maybe it is some experience with this kind of golf course, kind of this weather and kind of I think you learn when to be aggressive, when to be defensive and stay off the bogeys, because the birdies, you have a lot of chances. But tomorrow's going to be a lot of guys chasing, so it there's going to be some low scores to avoid, so yeah.

Q. Played college golf with Camilo. How comforting is it to have someone in that final pairing that you've played with?

ALEX NOREN: Yeah, it's like Ryan Moore, we played college together, too, and now we're talking about kids and their sports. We're all getting very much older.

But yeah, it's going to be fun tomorrow. I know Schmid as well, so it will be fun.
