

Q. Just minutes after the final putt, haven't had too much time to reflect, but what's the general emotions right now?

ALEX NOREN: Well, I'm pretty proud of how I played most of the day. I think Camilo definitely won the tournament and he played better than me. So I'm very not happy that I didn't, you know, play the way I needed to win obviously, but I played OK, I played pretty good.

So it's mixed emotions, but overall feeling is quite pleased with my game and looking forward to next week, and my coach is going to be there, so overall pretty pleased.

Q. We talked to Camilo earlier this week and how he finished runner-up last week in Mexico, kind of talked about how it's not easy, you guys make it look easy. What kind of were those nerves coming in with the lead today?

ALEX NOREN: Yeah, it's different I think when there's a bunch of guys at the top. I knew I had to play well. It's not -- you really couldn't kind of keep the lead by just playing conservative.

I wasn't that nervous actually and I knew -- you know, kind of put pressure on myself before when I've been in the lead and it hasn't worked out. So I just -- you know, whoever pulls the lowest round after four is the winner. So it doesn't really matter what you do coming into the fourth round as long as you've got a shot for it. Changed that mindset a little bit, which helped I think today.

But I couldn't -- a few wayward shots on the back nine, got pretty windy and it was so different from yesterday, the wind direction, so some shots played pretty tough.

Just not as good a game as Camilo today.

Q. And with that with Camilo, kind of how happy were you to see him win?

ALEX NOREN: Oh, it's great. My wife is close to his wife and I know what he's been through, and it's terrible what happened to him and his family, so I'm so happy for him. I've got kids of my own and I know how -- I can't imagine.

So I'm very, very happy for him and the way he played and the way he's handled his life after, it's remarkable.

Q. A strong runner-up finish this week, in good contention with a final event remaining, coach will be out with you next week, what are the big takeaways looking forward to next week?

ALEX NOREN: Just going about it more like I did this week compared to other weeks. Maybe I'll try to work on too much, work too much at a tournament, I'm maybe known for that, all the players at least.

So just keep at it. I know what works out there on the course and I just have to keep doing what I've been doing to kind of ingrain it even more.
