

Q. Adam, how would you characterize this performance this week? You had fun coming back to Bermuda and you played nicely, top-5 finish.

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, I played nicely. You know, once you're up at 20 under, it's splitting hairs on a shot here or there and that's all it is for the week. You know, tricky conditions today, you had to be really on and just got off to a slow start. The wind switched and maybe having not played here for a long time, just didn't have the course knowledge early to feel super comfortable, but as the round got going it was much better.

Q. You made a lot of birdies, you made three eagles for the week. It's the shortest course on the PGA TOUR. Is it fun for you to play a course like this, a venue that gives up a lot of scores like that?

ADAM SCOTT: It is if you're playing well, for sure. Look, earlier in the week when the wind was lighter it was great, I was in the fairway a lot, I hit a lot of great wedge shots. I felt really confident with my wedges after the first round. It's nice to kind of get going under par sometimes. We play some pretty hard courses throughout the year and breaking par is hard sometimes, so I enjoy going a little deeper when you can.

Q. I wanted to ask you about your putter and Camilo's, he's using the same brand of putter and he's just taken a two-shot lead with one to play. Is there any connection there amongst you two? I know during the Presidents Cup he was a co-captain, a vice captain. How did that come about? How long has sort of he been experimenting or using that, and you as well?

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, we kind of did a little scouting trip to Quail Hollow after the TOUR Championship last year before the Presidents Cup and there you get to really hang with the guys with very little commitment. Camilo and I were talking about his golf and putting and I kind of -- I think I introduced him to the LAB putter at that point. I at least gave him the contact of Sam at LAB.

He's been putting great with it. He's obviously very comfortable. In the last couple weeks has been incredible, so I'm stoked for Camilo. He's such a positive guy. To see him playing well again is nice for an old mate.

Q. And you mentioned earlier in the week that you're heading down to Australia in a couple weeks. How much confidence and incentive does this give you with this performance this week knowing that you can take it deep and head down there with some form?

ADAM SCOTT: Well, it was really one of the reasons for coming to play was to kind of make sure I'm not rusty when I play at home. I want to play well down there. I want to play well every week, but if I didn't play great this week, I would have known what to do when I got there and not just guessing.

But I really like where things are at. There's a lot of good stuff to take out of my game this week and if I play in similar style down there, hopefully I can end up on top.
