**COMPLETED Second-Round Notes – Saturday, November 16, 2024**

**Saturday weather:** Cloudy with intermittent showers. High of 71. Wind NW 25-35 mph, gusting to 50 mph.

**Suspension Summary:** Round two was suspended due to darkness Friday at 5:20 p.m. local time with 11 players yet to finish. The second round resumed at 6:57 a.m. Saturday and was completed at 7:26 a.m. Third-round tee times will feature threesomes off Nos. 1 and 10 from 8:08 – 10:20 a.m.

**36-Hole Cut:** 75 players at 2-under 140 from a field of 118 professionals and two amateurs.

**Justin Lower (1<sup>st</sup>/-12)**

- A week removed from his T2 at last week's World Wide Technology Championship, this week's 18-hole co-leader opened with back-to-back 6-under 65s in his fourth start at the Butterfield Bermuda Championship
- Needed 21 putts to complete his round, his fewest in a single round on TOUR; ties the fewest number of putts in a round at this event (Stewart Cink, Scott Stallings, Chase Seiffert)
- Butterfield Bermuda Championship history: T20/2023, T8/2022, T17/2021
- Best 36-hole position in 94 PGA TOUR starts before this week, solo-second at the 2024 Corales Puntacana Championship, resulted in a T4 finish
- In addition to last week's career-best finish of T2 in Mexico, claimed additional top-10 finishes this season at the Mexico Open at Vidanta (T3), Corales Puntacana Championship (T4) and Procore Championship (T7)
- Began the week at No. 74 in the FedExCup Fall standings and seeks to earn access into the first two Signature Events (outside of The Sentry) next season via the Aon Next 10

**Additional notes**

- Making his third start in the Butterfield Bermuda Championship, **Robby Shelton** (T2/-10) made five birdies and an eagle en route to a bogey-free 7-under 64, one stroke shy of his season's lowest; in two previous starts in the event, missed the cut in 2019 and finished T23 in 2023 after opening with an 8-under 63; one top-10 finish in 25 starts this season prior to this week: T9/Charles Schwab Challenge; came into the week No. 157 in the FedExCup
- Making his second Butterfield Bermuda Championship start (T5/2023), **Ryan Moore** (T2/-10) signed for a second-round 6-under 65; lone top-10 among 11 made cuts in 24 starts this season was T5 at the Valspar Championship; came into the week No. 152 in the FedExCup; seeks a sixth career win on TOUR and first since the 2016 John Deere Classic
- With 10 birdies against a lone bogey (No. 18), **Sam Ryder** (T4/-9) tied his career-low score of 9-under 62 (2019 Shriners Open/R4); 10 birdies ties his single-round record for most on TOUR (2023 Sanderson Farms Championship/R1); in two previous Butterfield Bermuda Championship starts, missed the cut in 2019 and 2023; began the week No. 135 in the FedExCup; has finished each of his previous six seasons on TOUR inside the top 125
- In his first Butterfield Bermuda Championship, **Kevin Kisner** (T4/-9) came into the week after four consecutive missed cuts; is vying for his fifth career win on the PGA TOUR and first since the 2021 Wyndham Championship

- Making his first start on the PGA TOUR since the 2023 Butterfield Bermuda Championship (MC), **Chris Baker** (T59/-2) followed a 4-over 75 in round one with a 6-under 65 in round two to make the cut on the number at 2-under 140.
- In his bid to become the first player to successfully defend the tournament's title, **Camilo Villegas** will begin round three at 2-under 140
- **Nick Hardy** (MC/-1) holed a 180-yard 7-iron at the par-5 17<sup>th</sup> hole for an albatross; marks the first in tournament history and fifth this season on TOUR
- The three Bermudians in the field all missed the cut: **Camiko Smith** (+1), **Eric West** (+3) and **Nick Jones** (+5)
- **Scott Piercy** (injury), **MJ Daffue**, **Wilson Furr** and **Paul Barjon** withdrew during round two; **Raul Pereda** was disqualified during round two.
