**Weather:** Cloudy with intermittent showers. High of 71. Wind NW 25-35 mph, gusting to 50 mph.

**Andrew Novak (T1/-16)**

- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 85<sup>th</sup> start
- Cards his lowest round on TOUR with a 9-under 62 (previous: 63/R4/2022 World Wide Technology Championship)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the first time on TOUR
- Birdies seven of his first nine holes to post his career-low nine-hole score (29) and equal the 9-hole scoring record at this event (7-under 29/front nine)
- 197 marks his low 54-hole total on TOUR (previous: 199/twice)
- Best finish on TOUR is T7 at the 2024 John Deere Classic, one of six top-10s on TOUR; notched three consecutive top-10s earlier this season (T8/WM Phoenix Open, T8/Mexico Open at Vidanta, T9/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- First-ever round at this event was 75 (+4/R1/2022), while all 12 rounds since are under par
- Began the week No. 93 in the FedExCup Fall standings and is projected No. 56 seeking to secure a spot in the Aon Next 10; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational

**Rafael Campos (T1/-16)**

- In his 80<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR start, seeks his first PGA TOUR win
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the third time on TOUR (2021 Puerto Rico Open/T3, 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship/T2)
- 197 marks his low 54-hole total on TOUR (previous: 202/2021 Puerto Rico Open)
- 9-under 62 marks his career-low on TOUR (previous: 63/R4/2024 CJ CUP Byron Nelson); nine birdies ties his most birdies in a single round on TOUR (R1/2017 Puerto Rico Open)
- Following his lone top-10 this season at THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson (T9), missed the cut in 13 of his next 15 starts (not including this week)
- Began the week No. 147 in the FedExCup Fall standings and is projected No. 80

**Additional notes**

- Tied for the lead with one hole to play, **Justin Lower** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-15), the 18- and 36-hole leader/co-leader, finds the penalty area with his tee shot and makes bogey; 198 marks his low 54-hole total on TOUR (previous: 200/three times)
- With a 10-under 61, **Wesley Bryan** (4<sup>th</sup>/-13) cards career-low 18-hole score to tie the tournament record (Taylor Pendrith/R2/2021, Alex Noren/R1/2022); also equals the 9-hole scoring record at this event (6-under 29/back nine); makes two eagles in his round (Nos. 7 and 17) and three total this week (No.7/R1); began the week No. 128 in the FedExCup Fall standings and is projected No. 112
- **Alex Smalley** (T8/-11) cards his 15<sup>th</sup> consecutive round under par at Port Royal Golf Course, with all but two in the 60s
- Defending champion **Camilo Villegas** sits T39 at 7-under

**FedExCup Fall Notes**

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Currently projected to move into Nos. 51-60: **Andrew Novak** (T1; from No. 93 to No. 56), **Lucas Glover** (T5; from No. 62 to No. 57)
- Currently projected to fall out of Nos. 51-60: **Justin Rose** (DNP; from No. 59 to No. 61), **Kevin Yu** (MC; from No. 60 to No. 62)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
- Currently projected to move into the Top 125: **Rafael Campos** (T1; from No. 147 to No. 80), **Wesley Bryan** (4<sup>th</sup>; from No. 128 to No. 112), **Sam Ryder** (T5; from No. 135 to No. 124)
- Currently projected to fall out of the Top 125: **Joel Dahmen** (MC; from No. 121 to No. 126), **Henrik Norlander** (T65; from No. 122 to No. 127), **Daniel Berger** (T60; from No. 124 to No. 128)
