Q. So, first off, just some thoughts on being here, having the opportunity to play together in a place that's obviously pretty special to both of you?

But then that quickly transitioned to like, oh, boy I'm playing in a PGA TOUR event, like what is that going to look like for me? I'm a YouTuber.

WESLEY BRYAN: Just the highs and low.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: Yeah. No, it really was like we'll be looking back on this like we played two rounds in a PGA TOUR event together. Yes, really special.

WESLEY BRYAN: Yeah, it was fun.

Q. And you had Camiko on your bag last year?

Q. George, any big takeaways from this week? I know you're going to second stage Q-School coming up.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: Tournament golf's not over, guys.

WESLEY BRYAN: Get better.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: Yeah. Second stage of Q-School --

WESLEY BRYAN: Practice.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: The putter -- yeah, it's gonna be -- there'll be a lot of positives because this whole week the game didn't feel as good as it did last year across the board, but I still was able to hit decent shots and put together stretches of good golf. So I think leaning into the fact that hey, it doesn't have to go perfect to be able to execute. The driver was really good and short game, even though stats are going to say it was awful, I hit a lot of pretty good chip shots. But boy the putter, we have two weeks to --

GEORGE BRYAN IV: -- to recalibrate, to recalibrate because it didn't work this week. But yeah, that's golf. It's been good for probably eight months and it was just due to have a --

GEORGE BRYAN IV: Yeah, it wasn't good this week. No, I'm excited to compete again and, you know, probably be a little less windy at second stage.

WESLEY BRYAN: Maybe.

Q. Was having a chance to see him in the heat of the battle, any observations --

GEORGE BRYAN IV: Yeah, I want your thoughts unfiltered, let's go.

WESLEY BRYAN: Well, I'll tell you what, I didn't think his ball-striking was as good as it usually is. He definitely was playing mental gymnastics out there.

WESLEY BRYAN: Hearing his dialogue with the caddie made me kind of realize how he just, it's just out there just going ping ping ping ping ping.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: One of your gifts is like your lack of caring. You do care, but you're just like able to hit golf shots and not care what the result is. And to see it in action -- like I've seen it on YouTube and I've seen it like outside the ropes, but like it's fun to watch because I aspire to be that way and I think a lot of guys playing this game like aspire to do that, but it's like how can like -- you said like let's try like a 5-iron around a tree and just -- and you're like --

WESLEY BRYAN: Yeah, around the tree, that's what I was doing all day.

GEORGE BRYAN IV: But no, fun week so far. And it's not done.

WESLEY BRYAN: For one of us. And the other part was it was a weird dynamic. I'm like upset knowing that George has got no chance of making the cut and here I am kind of in contention. It was like a weird array of emotions out there.
