ROBBY SHELTON (-10)



Q. Robby, in with a 7-under 64, how much different was today from yesterday?

ROBBY SHELTON: Yeah, it was a lot calmer after Wednesday and Thursday blowing 40 it seemed like. It's pretty easy, honestly. Not easy, but the putter was a lot easier to control I feel like. It wasn't moving all over the place, so it was nice to get that finally for one day.

Q. When you wake up in the morning and you know that forecast is going to be like that and you had that opportunity to go out, how do you get in the mindset to take advantage of that?

ROBBY SHELTON: I don't know, I just think you're so used to it blowing to where it just makes it easier. When you wake up and you're in the morning tee time, it's usually calmer so you know you have to take advantage of the morning tee times.

Q. How would you describe your season this season? You shot 63, I think this is your second lowest round of the season, you shot 63 at the AmEx, but how would you describe your season overall?

ROBBY SHELTON: It's been not very good, it's been very slow. Kind of changing swing instructors and it's been a grind. Played well last year, but just didn't have the same feelings, trying to be too perfect. But now I feel like I'm super calm this week and these last two events just going to give it all I've got.

Q. And you came in here like obviously in the FedExCup rankings a little bit down there, so knowing that, I mean, how do you go into these last couple of events knowing that you just have to put the pedal down?

ROBBY SHELTON: Yeah, I think it's good for me, honestly. You know you have to play well and you know that you need to win. A top-5 would be great, but you're really looking for the win. You're not looking at the cutline, you're going out to win. That should be your mentality every week, but that's just not the case sometimes.

Q. What was the highlight for you today?

ROBBY SHELTON: Probably the eagle on 17. I made a dumb bogey there yesterday so just to have an eagle there to bounce back was nice.

Q. Can you describe that?



ROBBY SHELTON: Yeah, it was just a driver up the left, 6-iron to 12 feet under the hole and made it.
