ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART (-15)

Q. Adrien, nice playing, must be pretty satisfying to get in with a score like that today on this windy challenging day. What did you do well out there today?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: I was grinding well. It was good to start with a birdie, really played solid all day. Only made one bogey, which is pretty good in this wind. I think those two pars on 15, 16 were huge, those two holes played really hard today and that kind of kept the momentum going for me. Making a nice birdie on 17 was also big time and (indiscernible) on 18 (indiscernible) finish T-3, which is needed right now.

Q. Your best finish on Tour is T-6, which this could turn out to be your best finish so far in your short career, but coming in here 175 on the FedExCup standings and now looking like you're close inside the 150, how meaningful is that performance just with one event to go?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: A lot. Obviously every tournament I try to show up and win. Obviously I've been struggling a little bit this year, but to come out this week and just stay patient and give myself a lot of good looks and kind of be inside the top-20 all week is something really satisfying, and to be able to close today's round with a 5 under was I think a really good boost for my confidence.

Q. How will you approach next week?

ADRIEN DUMONT DE CHASSART: First probably take a day and a half off to reset, but the same way, just try to hit fairways, greens, try to make some birdies. I know it's going to be windy next week, which is good because I'm kind of dialed in right now with my low shots, so just play solid golf.
